#### **HOW IT WORKS**

- Meet individually (and privately) with Thompson representative Cayce Powell for one
  hour to learn more about how he can help you develop and evaluate your existing estate
  plans based on your values and objectives.
- After this meeting, determine if you wish to participate in the process, which includes two to six additional meetings depending on the compexity of your estate. You may include other family members or financial advisors in these meetings if you wish.
- During your time together, Cayce will help you clarify your personal values and goals.
   Once these are established, he can review your existing estate plan with you to see if it reflects your values. If not, he can work with you to develop a plan that does. If you do not have a plan, he can also help you create one. In addition, he can often suggest tax-saving strategies.
- Once your plan is finalized, Cayce will help you share the details with your own attorneys
  or other financial advisors so that they can draft the final document to implement the
  recommendations.
- You may discontinue this program at any time for any reason.

#### Latin America/Spanish Program





Exciting things are happening with our Latin America/Spanish program! Not only have we added the Gospel Videos to the website and app, but we are expanding our footprint in Cuba.

Our Latin America team is lead by Senior Producer, José Castillo. His team consists of two broadcasters, one editor, one technician, and a few writers. Members of our team are in Cuba, Nicaragua, and Guatemala. They work to produce programs for both the 59 and 29 minute radio broadcasts. With government approval, these are being made available through "The Package", a collection of digital material distributed weekly to people in Cuba through hard drives as a substitute to broadband internet.

A few weeks ago, a Cuban government representative signed a document officially authorizing us to record and broadcast La Voz Alegre in Cuba! They allow us to record our program in the state-sponsored radio station "Radio Ariguanabo." We were just informed that beginning March 2025, they will start broadcasting our half-hour program in that station FOR FREE! They are considering broadcasting our program in the provincial Radio Station, "Radio Artemisa" which would reach the six provinces in the western part of the Island, including Havana.

We are in awe at how God has worked and continues to work in our radio ministry. What has happened in Cuba is nothing short of a miracle. In the 1950's, Cuba declared itself to be an atheist nation and persecuted religious people. In the 1990's, they amended their constitution and declared to be a secular entity. The fact that Cuba is now open to tolerateing religion and is giving more freedom to talk about it publicly, can only be attributed to the work of God.
